Henry Müller was born in Germany in 1794. Most research shows that he was born in the Grand Duchy of Baden. U.S census records indicate that Henry was married twice and that Catharina was his second wife. Henry's first marriage produced Geogr born 1826, also a stone mason, who Henry was living with when the 1860 census was taken, indicating Henry died sometime after 1860.

Henry and Catharina were married about 1835 and their three children were born in Germany – Peter in 1837, our ancestor Anna Margaretha in 1839, and Louisa in 1842. However, there may have been more children from both of Henry's marriages.

Henry, Catharina, and his children emigrated from Germany to the United States about 1845 and settled in the German immigrant neighborhood of "Germantown" in Newark, NJ.

Research is ongoing and this chapter will grow as more becomes known.
